TRAIL PERMITS

Permits and trail maps are available at all EBMUD recreation area entrance locations (Lake Pardee, Lake Camanche North Shore, Lake Camanche South Shore), park administration offices and EBMUD Mokelumne Watershed & Recreation Division Office on East Camanche Parkway, during regular business hours.

TRAIL USER SHALL

1. Sign in on trail register form prior to using EBMUD trails.
2. Have, in their possession at all times, a valid Trail Use Permit or be accompanied by a valid Adult Trail Use Permit holder.
3. Exhibit and/or surrender permit upon request of EBMUD ranger, county law enforcement officer, or any other person duly authorized by EBMUD.
4. Stay on designated trails.
5. Use trails between sunrise and sunset only.
6. Close all gates after passing through them.
7. Use only designated restroom facilities.
8. Carry out and properly dispose of all litter.
9. Remove and dispose of all animal waste products from staging area.

TRAIL USER SHALL NOT unless otherwise posted or noticed

1. Smoke while on trail.
2. Build or light any fire on EBMUD property.
3. Make body contact with the waters of any reservoir or tributary stream on EBMUD property.
4. Fish from any reservoir or tributary stream on EBMUD property.
5. Disturb livestock, wildlife, or vegetation on EBMUD property.
6. Bring pets, firearms, motorized vehicles, stallions or colts on EBMUD Trails.
7. Damage or destroy any EBMUD property; including (but not limited to) fences, signs, locks, structures, buildings, etc.
8. Ride or lead any saddle or pack animal in a manner that might endanger any person or animal, or allow any such animal to stand unattended or untethered on EBMUD property,
9. Permit any saddle or pack animal to swim or wade in any reservoir or tributary stream on EBMUD property, or drink from Pardee reservoir.
10. Ride bicycles on EBMUD watershed trails.
11. Use any other EBMUD recreational facilities without paying applicable fees.

Trails may be closed at the discretion of EBMUD. Report unsafe conditions or other hazards to EBMUD. For Emergencies, Call 911. Identify the county and trail on which the emergency exists.
